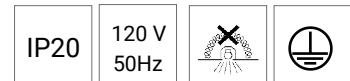
- Keep these instructions for future reference.
- Must be installed by a qualified electrician in accordance with national and local standards. Designplan is not responsible for fixtures installed without regard to these standards.
- Unauthorized alterations or tampering of product voids warranty.
- The main power connection must be in accordance with local electrical codes.
- Suitable for INDOOR applications.
- DO NOT INSTALL INSULATION WITHIN 3.0" (76 mm) OF ANY PART OF THE LUMINAIRE.



## Maintenance

Scheduled maintenance must be carried out once a year on all lighting devices, regardless of appliance class and type of use. It must include the following operations:

- Periodically clean fixtures to remove dirt from gratings and screw heads.
- Check tightness of screws on various parts of the device.
- Check that all cable glands and cables are intact and tight. Check that the glass or plastic lens is intact, and replace it if broken or damaged.
- The internal components such as the ballast, driver, washers and screws must not show clear signs of oxidation or rust. Clear traces of rust and oxidation will indicate the presence of water inside the device.
- In the case of damage, the components must be replaced by original components or spare parts.



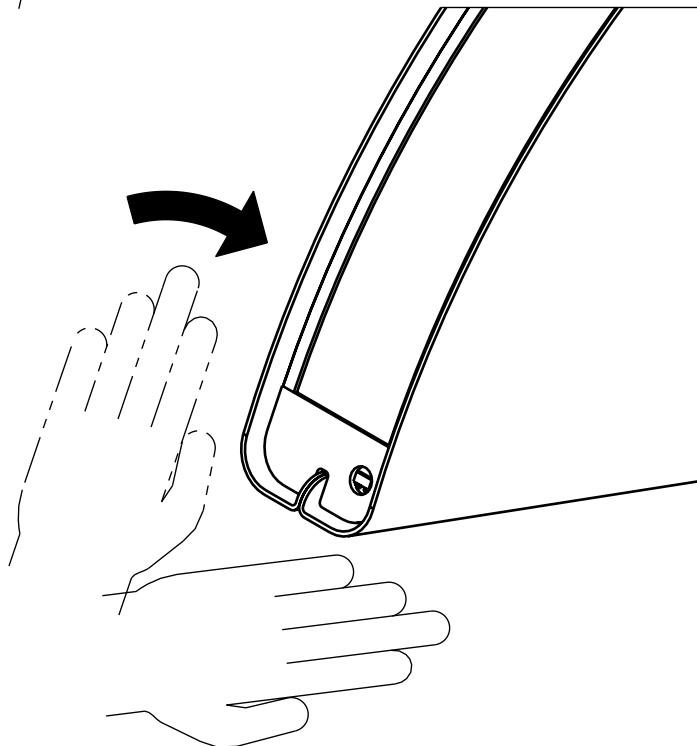
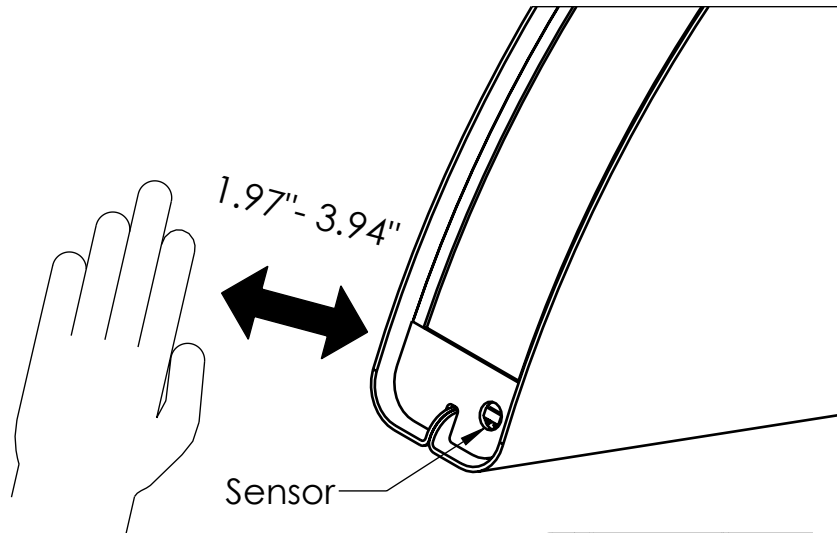
## EN General safety notes.

Install the luminaire according to the enclosed installation instruction. After removing the luminaire from the packaging, check that it is complete and no parts are damaged. If damage is found, do not install the luminaire. Before the installation, make sure that the power is off. Only qualified electricians may carry out the installation and servicing of luminaire. The installation and service of luminaire must be carried out in protective gloves. It is forbidden to make any changes on the luminaire without written permission from the manufacturer. Do not load (electrically and mechanically) the luminaire with additional components. If a luminaire fails, it must not be touched or further used. The luminaire must be switched off immediately. The luminaire may only be used again after being repaired and checked by a qualified electrician. All maintenance work must be carried out with the power switched off and the luminaire cooled down. Clean the luminaire only with a soft cloth. Do not use chemicals containing alcohol (risk of damage the external surface of the luminaire and diffuser). Chrome parts should be cleaned with a soft microfibre cloth without cleaning agents (risk of scratching). The manufacturer is not responsible for damage caused by incorrect installation and/or use of the luminaire. All operations performed on the device which are not in accordance with its instruction, void the manufacturer's warranty. Provide instruction to end users/customers for use in the future. Do not connect the controller while the power is on!



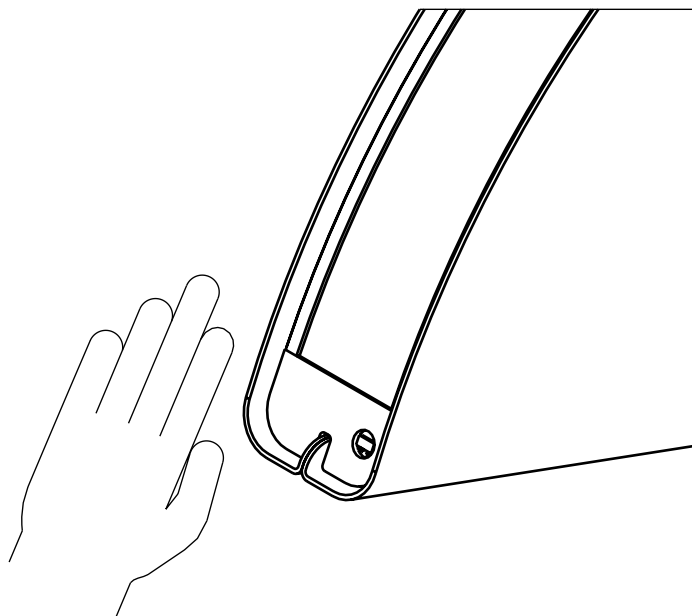
**PLUG IN THE CABLE WIRE FIRST**
